Seddon Homes unveils outstanding design plan for contemporary homes within sought-after conservation area

LEADING north west developer, Seddon Homes, has unveiled its blueprint for sensitively designed new homes on the edge of a conservation area in Chorlton.

Travis Gate will complement the surrounding area's distinctive mix of modern and traditional properties.

Built on the site of a former dairy, it will comprise nine three-storey town houses, each with off-road secure parking and private gardens.

The four-bedroom properties are imaginatively designed to blend in with the century-old Chorltonville conservation area, with its tree-lined roads and tidy grass verges.

Many properties in the area have design features such as gable motifs, sprocketed roofs with a gentler pitch towards the eaves, canted bays, circular windows and side windows splayed at an angle.

Travis Gate will replicate the traditional design theme with elegant porch-style roofs over front doors, mullioned bay windows and red brick facades, all in keeping with the architecture of the locality.

At 1800 to 1900 sq ft in size each, the homes are above-average sizes for new build.

Each will be equipped with high-spec modern features and appliances. These will include high-quality Siematic kitchens, eye-catching stainless steel appliances, an en-suite wet room, two further bathrooms and a downstairs cloakroom.
